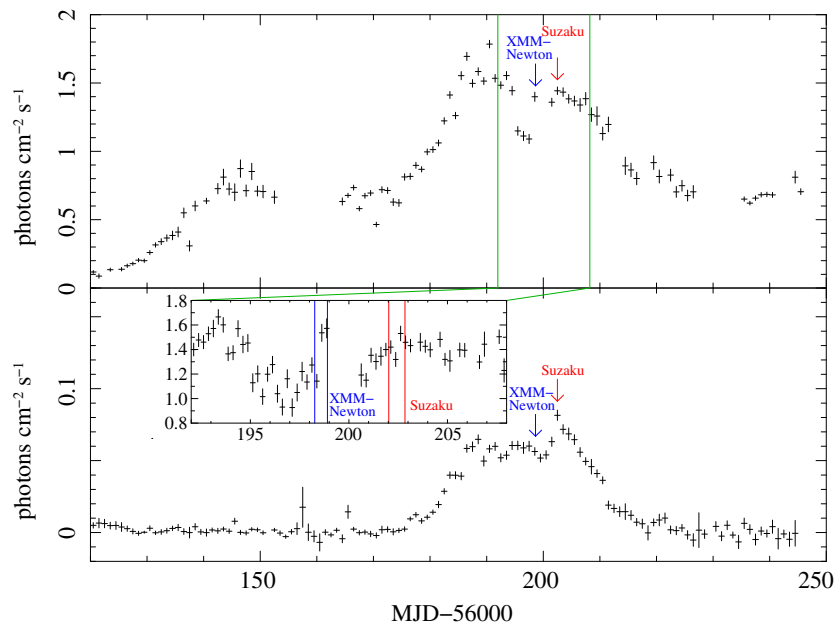


Figure 1. Long-term light curves of 4U 1630–47 in the 3–10 keV and 15–50 keV bands obtained with the *Monitor of All-Sky X-ray Image*/Gas Slit Camera (*MAXI*/GSC) (top panel) and *Swift*/BAT (bottom panel), respectively.

The photon flux of the *Swift*/Burst Alert Telescope (BAT) plotted in the bottom panel of Figure 1 in the published paper was overestimated by a factor of 4.15 because of an incorrect conversion factor between the count rate and photon flux.
